B. New Business

Neil Tunison and Andy Brossart, with assistance from Mark Hurst began the discussion concerning financial matters relating to funding of Southwest Warren County Projects and the WCTID available project funding and needs. Dan Corey reported that to date the program of projects for southwest area of Warren County which include: I-71/Field-Ertel/Mason-Montgomery Interchange, I-71/Western Row Road Interchange, Mason-Montgomery Road Corridor, Socialville-Fosters Road Corridor, Innovation Way Corridor, and Wilkens Boulevard Corridor, have been developed on a "cash in hand" basis.

A premier business, P&G, has committed over 1300 new jobs to its facility in Mason on Mason-Montgomery Road that would begin coming online in 2018. P&G asked that the program of projects for years 2018, 2019, and 2020 be advanced such that they would be completed in 2017 to provide for and accommodate the increasing transportation system demands. In order to facilitate the advancement of the various transportation improvement projects, options on leveraging or maximizing the committed pledged revenues by the County, from the P&G TIF funds, was discussed. In order to advance the program of projects approximately \$18M of available funding would need to be provided for.

Andrew Brossart went over the options for issuance of WCTID highway improvement bonds, with the debt serviced from the available P&G TIF revenues. The Committee asked questions regarding this option and the the revenue stream in place from the P&G TIF. Matt Nolan was to review the revenues and present his findings at the September 23rd meeting.

It was recommended that the TID Board retain Abbot Thayer with the Peck, Shaffer Williams division of Dinsmohr and Sholl, as bond counsel for this issuance. Mr. Thayer will submit an engagement letter to the Board for action.
