A. Call to Order

A Regular Board Meeting of the Warren County Transportation Improvement District (WCTID) Board of Trustees was called to order by the Chairperson, Mr. David Gully, at 9:05 a.m., Friday, October 28, 2011 at the Warren County Engineers Office, 105 Markey Road, Conference Room, Lebanon, Ohio 45036.

Mr. Neil Tunison, Secretary-Treasurer, took roll call; Mr. Tunison stated that Ms. Christine Thompson called, stating she would be at the meeting. Mr. Gully requested attendees to introduce themselves and state what company they represented; Ms. Thompson was duly noted as having arrived at 9:08 am.

B. Approval of Minutes: September 23, 2011 Board Meeting

Motion made by Mr. Tunison, seconded by Mr. Hansen, to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2011 Regular Meeting of the Warren County Transportation Improvement District as submitted, upon roll call vote, carried with each member present separately voting "yea" thereon.

C. Transportation Improvement Projects Progress Update

1. I-71 / Fields-Ertel Mason-Montgomery Road Interchange Area

Mr. Dan Corey stated a meeting at ODOT Central Office was held on September 27 and the Scope of Services for the I-71 North Bound Exit Ramp (ODOT PID No. 87399) has been defined; WCTID can issue a contract to the Consultant once the fee is agreed upon, then we can move to the resolution stage.

Mr. Corey stated there was no update on I-71 Northbound Loop Ramp from I-71 to Fields-Ertel Road (ODOT PID 81052) project.

2. I-71 / Western Row Road Interchange Project

Mr. Steve Shadix from ENTRAN stated that the Certified Traffic package has been submitted, comments from ODOT and City of Mason have been received and ENTRAN is addressing those comments.

3. I-75 / at SR73 Interchange Project

Mr. Corey stated that Scope of Services meeting had been held on October 7, 2011 at ODOT District 8 with Jim Hamilton and that a Scope Field Review meeting is to be scheduled.

D. Financial Report - Secretary - Treasurer

Mr. Tunison stated that WCTID financial report is included in today's packet it is looking good and they are at a point such that checks can be written. Mr. Gully inquired if there was any discussion regarding the WCTID financial report as submitted. Being no questions or further discussion Mr. Gully requested a motion be made to accept and approve the WCTID financial report as submitted, Mr. Hansen made a motion, seconded by Ms. Thompson, upon roll call vote, carried with each member present separately voting "yea" thereon.

E. Old Business

1. MVRPC update

Mr. Corey stated WCTID applied for and had been approved by MVRPC for membership. He further stated that an application has been submitted to MVRPC requesting construction funds that would provide a 20% Local Funds and 80% Federal Funds split.

F. New Business

1. Resolution No. 2011-09 A resolution authorizing Intergovernmental Agreement 2011-2012 with Deerfield Township:

Mr. Tunison stated Deerfield Township agrees to financially participate in funding for the TID and agrees to contribute \$1 million at the end of next week and further agrees that \$1 million will be contributed at the end of January 2012 and January 2013 to be applied to the Fields-Ertel Interchange Area Improvements. Being no questions or further discussion Mr. Gully requested a motion be made to accept and approve the Resolution No. 2011-09, Ms. Thompson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hansen, upon roll call vote, carried with each member present separately voting "yea" thereon.

2. Resolution No. 2011-10 A resolution by Warren County Transportation Improvement District Authoring Amendments and Changes to the Initial Budget:

Mr. Tunison stated Resolution No. 2011-10 modifies the budget as the original budget had been approved for \$7 thousand, however the bills currently total \$8 thousand. This has come about for the following reasons: more time had been spent on the WCTID legal and financial issues than expected and initially the fiscal year was expected to be July 1 through June 31 however it was brought to our attention that the fiscal year is January 1 through December 31, therefore the budget needs to be increased to cover the balance of this fiscal year. Being no questions or further discussion Mr. Gully requested a motion be made to accept and approve the Resolution No. 2011-10, Mr. Hansen made a motion, seconded by Mr. Becker, upon roll call vote, carried with each member present separately voting "yea" thereon.

G. Public Comments

Mr. Gully inquired if there were any public comments. Having received no public comments Mr. Gully took this time to thank ODOT for working with WCTID and further stated that he has heard only good things about their involvement. Mr. Schuermann inquired if Columbus ODOT should be advised of the additional funding commitment by Deerfield to the WCTID project. Mr. Fluegemann, ODOT District 8, stated a letter could be sent to make them aware.

H. Next Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Tunison stated that the next two WCTID meetings occur during the week of Thanksgiving and Christmas and suggest that these meetings be rescheduled to November 18 and December 16, respectively. Ms. Thompson inquired if the November and December meetings could be combined into one meeting. Discussion followed with the suggestion of cancelling the November 18th meeting and holding the next meeting on December 16th; being no questions or further discussion it was agreed that the November 18th meeting be cancelled.
