I-71 and Western Row Road Interchange Area

- Western Row Road Interchange Improvements Phase 1 (PID 95120)

- Western Row Road Interchange Improvements Phase 2 (PID 93964)

- Bid will be opened 11/22 and be awarded by WCTID

SR73/SR741 Intersection Improvements

Right-of-Way acquisition has four remaining parcels to be obtained

 - o Bid will be opened 11/17

Union/Greentree Intersection

 Bids will be opened in month of December and be awarded in January/February

D. Financial Report

Mr. Hurst presented the September 2016 Monthly Financial Report to the Board. The Monthly Financial Reports detailed both monthly and year-to-date cash activities for all funds of the WCTID. More specifically, the Monthly Financial Report detailed that as of September 30th, 2016 the General Fund had an ending fund balance of \$734,312.16 and the WCTID as a whole had an ending fund balance of \$16,142,271.05. Mr. Neil Tunison made a motion to accept the WCTID financial report as submitted, seconded by Ms. Christine Thompson. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon.

E. New Business

- Resolution No. 2016-32, a Resolution approving and authorizing notice to contractors and acceptance of bids for construction services for the WAR-48-8.80 Mason-Morrow-Millgrove (PID 94494) Project. Ms. Christine Thompson made a motion and Mr. Bill Becker seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon.
- Resolution No. 2016-33, a Resolution to provide for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$15,500,000 of Warren County Transportation Improvement District Roadway Improvement Revenue Bonds, for the purpose of financing

a portion of the cost of various road and highway projects and paying costs of issuance; to authorize the execution of a trust agreement in order to secure such bonds to be so issued; to authorize a term sheet and a bond placement agreement with respect to such bonds; to authorize the execution and delivery of all other necessary and appropriate agreement and instruments; and to authorize other actions necessary in connections with the forgoing. Mr. Neil Tunison made a motion and Ms. Christine Thompson seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon.

- Resolution No. 2016-34, a Resolution for amending certain fund budgets for calendar year 2016. Mr. Neil Tunison made a motion and Mr. Bill Becker seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon.
- 4. Resolution 2016-35, a Resolution approving amendment of Intergovernmental Agreement designating new projects with the Warren County Board of Commissioners. Ms. Tiffany Zindel noted that Exhibit B, under the County Fund 484 (P&G TIF Funds) the Yearly Revenue Available for TID Projects does not represent the most recent numbers provided by Mr. Matt Nolan, Warren County Auditor. Therefore, Ms. Tiffany Zindel made a motion to amend and replace the Exhibit B to the Intergovernmental Agreement with the version of Exhibit B containing the revised numbers provided by Mr. Matt Nolan, Warren County Auditor, Ms. Christine Thompson seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon. Mr. Neil Tunison made a motion to approve the Resolution 2016-35 as amended and Ms. Christine Thompson seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon.
- 5. Motion to authorize the Secretary-Treasurer, in consultation with WCTID Legal Counsel, to prepare and execute Change Order 01 to Consultant Agreement 2014-02 with CH2M HILL, Inc. dated February 28th, 2014 for the "Mason-Montgomery Road Widening Project", increasing the contract price by \$15,087.50, making a new not-to-exceed amount under the Agreement of \$493,605.44 with an increase in contract time through December 31, 2016. Mr. Bill Becker made a motion and Mr. Neil Tunison seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, motion carried with each member present separately voting "yes" thereon.
